#### PRAKRITI - THE SCIENCE FESTIVAL

Innovation is the process of implementing new ideas for finding better solutions to existing problems and inarticulate needs. It is about identifying and creating new approaches to do, what we have been doing so far. To tap the innovative potential of the students, the Science Department of the school organised a virtual 'Science Festival' on 18th December, 2020, which received enthusiastic response from students. They came out with multiple innovative solutions to problems related to health, climate change and pollution. Rajkaranveer Singh, a student of VI B made a Corona Sanitizing Tunnel to be used in the areas where there is high flow of people like at airports, malls, bus stations and even in schools. Adhya Verma of VI D created a model of volcano, which could trap geothermal energy and convert it into useful projects. Gunika Chug of IX B made a smoke absorber machine to control the level of pollution by absorbing contaminated air and purifying it. It is a device with a fan which filters the interior air by removing the airborne grease, bad odour, bacterial fumes etc. to the external environment. Harsimrat Kaur of VIII B made a precautionary band to prevent the touching of the face repeatedly to avoid the spread of Covid 19. Yuvika Gupta created an Automatic hand sanitizer whereas Rupashi Dhawan and Akanksha Snehal made a solar irrigation system which would use solar energy to irrigate the fields. Some other projects introduced during this festival were a smart glimmer, a multipurpose stove, a vertical axis wind propeller and a rooftop rainwater harvesting.

Five students were selected for preliminary round, out of which two got selected for final and they were Surkhab and Harshil.














### 2 and 3 Dimensional Shapes

For the past 9 years, 22nd December every year in India is observed as National Mathematics Day to commemorate the birth anniversary of India's mathematical genius Srinivasa Ramanujan. They constructed wonderful models like water dispenser, park, garden, valley of shapes, robot, garage, house, multipurpose hanging holder, castle, etc using 2D and 3D shapes. Finally, they all explained their models confidently and put in their best efforts throughout. The activity generated great interest among all the students.



### The Journey of Food – Farm to Plate


Inter Class Activity | Class 3 | (16th October, 2020)






#### Save Cultural Wonders of the World




### Talk on Mars' Closest Approach to Earth

#### **BEST PRACTICES IN ART INTEGRATION IN ENGLISH**

#### Online training session by DPS HRD Centre

A fantabulous online training session 'Best Practices In Art Integration (English)' was attended by Ms.Geeta Malik. It was organized by the DPS Society-Human Resource Development Centre. It was introduced quite enthusiastically by Ms.Vanita Kher. During this virtual session, sixteen panelists from the various offshoots of DPS showcased their skills and enriched the participants with their knowledge. Different concepts of language and literature were taught through different art ideas. The topics like tenses, prose, poetry, story writing, adjectives, figures of speech, prepositions, degrees of comparison were covered under the workshop. The main idea behind the art ideas was to make the learning more interesting by indulging students in the various activities.

Ms.Shampa Dutta from DPS, Bhopal taught tenses through a tense song. An amalgamation of art and literature was done by Soubiya Wani from DPS, Budgam. She emphasized on teaching poetry through sketches, movies, drama and art. Sharing beautiful sketches and drawings made by her own students, she laid stress on the pictorial representation. Ms.Karamjit Kaur from DPS, Chandigarh highlighted the significance of storytelling in teaching English.

Ms Sukhwinder Kaur from DPS Daulatpurl taught adjectives using puppets and Ms Sugandha Siddharth from DPS Dibrugarh looked after the figures of speech. The latter used ppt presentations, videos and songs to teach the literary devices. She talked about the assignment to be given to the students where they would create some examples of metaphor on charts e.g., you are a bad banana.

The next session wasby Aditi Chaturvedi from DPS Indira Nagar about teaching literature. The objective was to enhance vocabulary and listening skills. Language acquisition was handled by Ms Reena Kahlon from DPS Jalandhar.

Here she highlighted the idea of showing films for the purpose. She considered it as an efficient tool which nudges to listen, speak, think and form impressions. Lyrical and dramatic rendition of poetry done by Ms. Radhika Dua from DPS Kalyanpur. The basic idea was to arouse interest of the students towards poetry. Ms. Mahasweta Sengupta from DPS Khanapara used drawings and paintings to teach prepositions. Ms. Harpreet Kaur Bhamra from DPS Nadergul used songs and pictioniries to express the concept of similes.

Ms.Debyani Brahma from DPS Newtown focused on teaching degrees of comparison. Ms.Priyanka K Goswami from DPS Numaligarh elaborated on the use of music, paintings, drama, dance to teach poetry.

Ms Tanvi Misra from DPS Gwalior taught the way to prose. Ms. Baljeet and Mr. Pannaga k Murthy from DPS Vijayawada introduced the idea of using paper art, drawing, cartoon making to teach figures of speech and comic strips to explain poems. In a way, the entire workshop focussed on using different art forms to teach English.

### **Pre-School Teaching**


Virtual teacher training program by CBSE | (27th November, 2020)

A thorough discussion on how children learn to strengthen their social and emotional development was also done. Various skill-based activities that enhance the 7 domains of early childhood development were also discussed.

The workshop helped a long way in understanding how they could be more confident, empowered, sensitive and aware facilitators of preschool teaching.



#### MATHS – BEST PRACTICES IN ART INTEGRATION

#### Webinar by DPS HRD Centre | (23rd November, 2020)

A webinar on the theme 'Maths - Best Practices in Art Integration was conducted by DPS Society on 23rd November, 2020.

The opening session by Ms. Deepika Saxena motivated teachers to integrate rhymes and jingles in teaching Mathematics. The next session was like a charge of energy and creative ideas. Some more innovative and productive ideas were shared by Ms Harsimrat Kaur, who ignited participants' curiosity by integrating art with linear Equations, String Art and Curve Stitching with geometry.

To conclude, the entire virtual training session was extremely fruitful, interactive, lively and innovative. The main objective was to promote Art, Dance, Theatre and Crafts to make Mathematics an easier and joyful subject.




